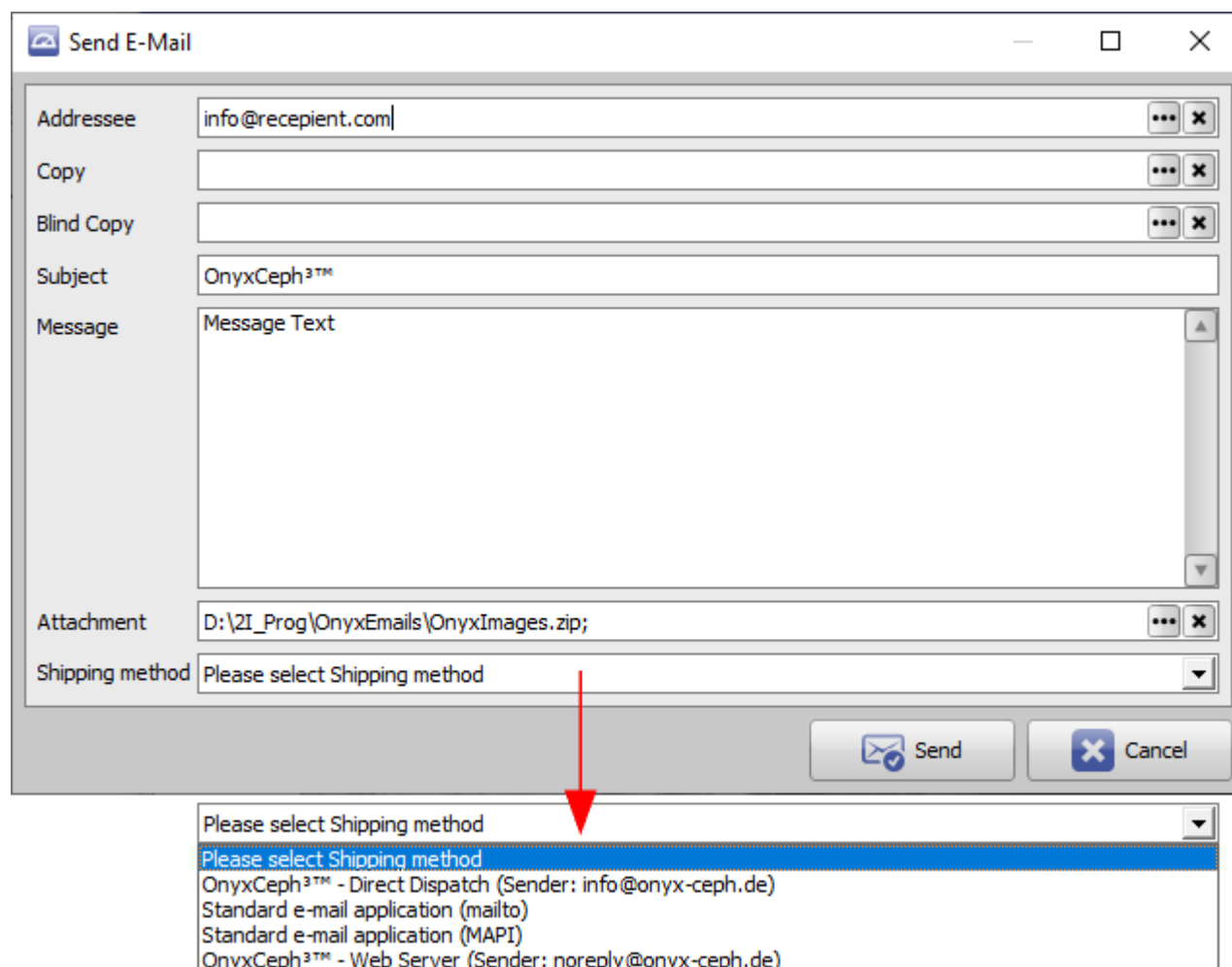


# E-mail - Shipping Methods

An e-mail message with or without an attachment can be sent from OnyxCeph<sup>3</sup>™ at various points. The standardized shipping dialog offers different shipping methods:

- Direct Dispatch
- Standard Email Application (mailto)
- Standard Email Application (MAPI)
- Web Server Dispatch



## Method Description

Method	Description	Attachments
Direct Dispatch	Direct sending of e-mails via the e-mail client integrated in OnyxCeph. Configurable via the <a href="#">System Options - Tab E-Mail</a> .	Yes
mailto	Opening the standard e-mail application for sending indirect e-mails. Can be configured via the <a href="#">Windows™ system settings</a> . The sender is defined by the standard e-mail application.	No
MAPI	Opening the standard e-mail application for sending indirect e-mails. Can be configured via the <a href="#">Windows™ system settings</a> . The sender is defined by the standard e-mail application.	Yes

Method	Description	Attachments
Web Server	Direct sending of e-mails via the OnyxCeph web server. The sender is always noreply@onyx-ceph.de. Therefore, the e-mail recipient cannot reply directly.	No
